Von Stiehl Winery boasts two kinds of spirits

Fox Valley Ghost Hunters spent two nights at the Von Stiehl Winery in Algoma looking for spirits of a different kind and plan to reveal their findings from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Nov. 10.

The von Stiehl building was originally a brewery built in 1868. The business was sold in 1879 to Henry Schmiling, the great-great-great-uncle of the current owners Eric and Brad Schmiling. The brewery went out of business, and after many years of various uses the building was purchased and restored in the 1960s by Dr. Charles Stiehl to be used as a winery. Stiehl later changed his name to von Stiehl.

Fox Valley Ghost Hunters, a seven-member nonprofit group, investigates up to 17 ghostly happenings a year, mainly in Wisconsin and Michigan's Upper Peninsula.

According to Sallie Marquardt, retail manager at von Stiehl, over the years people have seen apparitions in the women's bathroom, a board fall out of nowhere in the tasting room, smooth river stones that turn up in odd places, people being shoved and hair pulled, and odd waxy smudges on mirrors around the building.

that there is something going bump in the night at von Stiehl.

Nehring said the group identified a number of spirits, including one who said his name was "Christopher."

The most "awesome" thing that happened during the investigation was when the group was in one of the storage rooms above the distribution center, Nehring.

He and others were asking the spirits questions when they heard the floor creaking. When Nehring asked if his questions were making the spirit mad, a door slammed narrowly missing his shoulder.

"We even tried to recreate it, and we couldn't," he said.

The group also recorded what appears to be ghost appearing in a doorway for just a second. Nehring had several other paranormal groups check the recording to see if someone from his team was casting a shadow. It wasn't a shadow.

"Very rarely does anyone get any sort of shadow or movement," he said.

The unveiling of evidence will take place from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Nov. 10 at von Stiehl, 115 Navarino St., Algoma.

"Periodically people do see something, yes. Do I ever see anybody? No," Marquardt said.

The ghostly happenings are not limited to von Stiehl's tasting room or business offices.

"Quite some shenanigans have taken place in the other building (distribution)," Marquardt said. Those incidences include banging noises and people

having their legs grabbed. It's rumored that the storage space above the plant was a brothel at one time. The building is about a block away from the winery.

Because of this and more, the Fox Valley Ghost Hunters were very much welcomed to visit this past September.

"Some of my other counterpart paranormal groups said that it was haunted," said Craig Nehring, a semi driver and founder of the Fox Valley Ghost Hunters.
